Chicago

Your Route 66 holiday begins with a two night stay in "The Windy City". Enjoy a narrated Architectural cruise to see over 40 landmarks and learn about the engineering and 130-year history of Chicago.



Route 66 in Illinois

Stop at Route 66 landmarks like the Old Joliet Prison, the Gemini Giant, the Ambler/Becker Texaco Station, visit the Abraham Lincoln Presidential Library and Museum, and the Illinois State Fairgrounds' Legends Neon Park.



Springfield

Visit Abraham Lincoln Home National Historic Site, tour the Frank Lloyd Wright-designed Dana-Thomas House, stop for photos at Shea's Gas Station and the restored Route 66 brick road, and visit the Old Chain of Rocks Bridge.



St. Louis

Visit Gateway Arch National Park, explore the Museum of Western Expansion, take a narrated Mississippi River cruise, enjoy a treat at Ted Drewes Frozen Custard, and visit the National Museum of Transportation.



Route 66 in Missouri

Drive through Lone Elk Park, visit the Meramec Caverns to explore its limestone formations and Native American artifacts, and stop at the Fanning 66 Outpost to see the giant Red Rocking Chair.



Route 66 in Kansas

See the Kan-O-Tex Service Station, Route 66 Visitors Center, the Blue Whale of Catosau, and Pops 66 diner with its giant soda bottle. Take a guided tour of Oklahoma City and visit the National Cowboy & Western Heritage Museum.

- Enjoy a tasty treat at Ted Drewes Frozen Custard and have dinner at Panera's on the Hill
- Tour the National Museum of Transportation and see its amazing collection of vehicles
- Missouri Route 66 attractions including Lone Elk Park and the Fanning 66 Outpost 40-foot tall Red Rocking Chair
- Visit Meramec Caverns filled with rare and colorful mineral formations
- Kansas Route 66 sites including the Kan-O-Tex Service Station, the Route 66 Visitors Center and the March with "Rainbow Bridge"
- Photo stops at the Blue Whale of Catosau and Pops 66 landmark diner
- Enjoy a narrated tour of Oklahoma City, including the Oklahoma City National Memorial
