Day 1 Sheraton Vancouver Wall Centre, Vancouver, British Columbia

Days 2 – 8 Holland America Koningsdam

Day 1: Friday, July 11, 2025 Vancouver, British Columbia Arrive today in the city of Vancouver, a bustling west coast seaport and cosmopolitan city.

Day 2: Saturday, July 12, 2025 Vancouver - Board Cruise Embark on your 7-night Inside Passage Holland America cruise aboard a fabulous floating resort designed to make your stay on board truly memorable. You will be dazzled by the entertainment in the state-of-the-art lounges and a myriad of dining options. While on board, breakfast, lunch, dinner and nightly entertainment are included. (B, L, D)

Day 3: Sunday, July 13, 2025 Cruising - Inside Passage Northbound A wonderful day of sightseeing awaits as your ship sails along the amazing Inside Passage, an extensive coastal route known for its natural beauty and abundant wildlife. (B, L, D)
